In December 2008 nearly 500 individual gift parcels were distributed to disadvantaged children in Sri Lanka.

The 100 children attending the Bethlehem Creche were amongst them.

The Creche situated in a slum area is run by the Carmelite Nuns and a small band of young women who lovingly care for these little ones while their Mums go to work. Most are single parents—some widowed or abandoned. They all have their own sad stories. Some work as domestics, on building sites or sweep the streets. Their daily wage is barely enough to keep themselves alive let alone house, feed and educate the family. The new set of clothes is something they cherish & cannot provide because of the poverty cycle they live in. Most don't own a pair of shoes!

Since the tsunami Sister Alex - Our Partner in Sri Lanka has been helping tsunami women start micro enterprises.

Quilted cards (a skill learned from 2 Aussies who visited the area) is being turned into a small business. These cards are now available on order 2 for \$3. The last shipment was of a high standard and sold like hot

Network Heaven works with local partners in Sri Lanka headed by Sister Alex from the Sisters of Charity in Galle. Sister Alex works amongst the poor and disadvantaged. Due to the global economic melt down these families earning under \$3 per day have had the number of work days cut from 30 to 12. They face severe hardship with no help in sight.
