Student Sponsorships Update and news from Wasana & Shashikala

This year we have 2 students at University and a 3rd student undertaking a 1 year montessori pre-school training course.

There were 15 people who have contributed to providing the much needed assistance to both Wasana and Shashikala who have to live away from home to attend university. Both girls have worked hard over many years to gain entry into university. However, they need assistance to live away from home and come from low income families. They did not have the basics eg clothing and stationery or funds for travel. So, in January this year an appeal was sent out via e-mail asking if people would donate funds to cover their cost for 12 months. Thank You to every-

one who made this possible, The girls have appreciated your kindness and really value the opportunity you have given them this year.

Wasana is in her 1st year studying for an engineering degree at the University of Peradeniya which is in the hill country and approximately 180 miles from her hometown Galle in southern Sri Lanka. Shashikala is in 1st year studying Architectural Design at the University of Moratuwa and has rented a room close to the university which is about 60 miles from her home.

Both students have advised they have passed their first semester exams.

Our 3rd student Angeline who is studying for a Montesori teachers course hopes to complete the

course at the end of 2012.

There are another 40 students who are part of the Educational Scholarships scheme who range in ages from 6 to 19. All of them are from very poor families who struggle to put food on the table let alone attend school. Each child receives the sum of around A\$10 per month to assist with bus fares, shoes and school stationery and also attend coaching class where appropriate. Since the scholarships Scheme is not fully funded for a whole year the balance funds have to be found by Sister Alex Molligoda who runs the programme in Sri Lanka.
